

*Balloonfest, Air Show and So Much More* is implementing a “Tailgate” option, with a limited number of vehicles parking on the fairgrounds “track”. Each vehicle in the Tailgate area will be assigned a private 20’ x 20’ area for you and your vehicle.

**1 PASS PER VEHICLE. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING, EXCEPT IN THE CAMPING AREA. PLEASE TAKE YOUR TRASH WITH YOU WHEN LEAVING THE AIRSHOW.**

### **CAMPING ON THE GROUNDS-LIMITED AVAILABILITY**

Self-contained camping is available in a specified area on the grounds beginning at 4:00 pm Friday through 4:00 pm Sunday. Please see our website for camping information.

*Can I bring my own food and drinks?*

Sure! You can bring prepared items, but no cooking or heating of food is allowed. Also, no glass containers are allowed, no alcohol, please. There will be food and beverage vendors on the grounds.

*How many people can be in my vehicle for the Tailgate?*

You can have as many people as the number of seat belts in your vehicle. This is for safety reasons as well as for your group’s viewing enjoyment.

*What can and can't I bring?*

Here’s the rundown:

You are welcome to bring:

- Tables, chairs, or blankets
- Small golf umbrellas up to 60 inches across
- Coolers, including food and beverages (NO ALCOHOL OR GLASS PLEASE)
- Service animals (please pickup after your animals) (**ONLY SERVICE ANIMALS!!! PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS AND THIS WILL BE ENFORCED**)

Prohibited items include:

- Generators
- Glass containers

- POP-UP or pole tents
- Beach umbrellas
- Grills of any type
- Animals, except for service animals
- Golf carts, ATVs, bicycles, skates, skateboards, and roller blades
- Drones
- No alcohol
- Guns and other weapons

Please note that vehicles are subject to search by law enforcement while at the airshow.

*Are pets allowed?*

Pets are not allowed, but service animals are welcome with their hosts. Please be prepared to have confirmation of “service animal” status. This is the policy of the fairgrounds.

*How will I be checked in?*

Your ticket will be scanned at **Gate 3**. Have it ready – either a printout or with the ticket image ready on your phone. The parking staff will guide you to the next available parking spot in your designated area. *Please note, you may only move your vehicle with an escort. A phone number will be assigned for you to call for an escort when needed.*

*Can I keep my engine running in the Tailgate area?*

Please keep your engine use to a minimum. Also, headlights and parking lights should be off at all times. If you have car trouble or an emergency, please notify a roving security officer or parking attendant of an emergency or other situation.
